The applications are granted in part.


The parties have been directed to supply the Court, by November 12, 2002, with redacted copies of the sealed portions of the record, consistent with this Court's rulings in its Memorandum and Decision of November 4, 2002. Redacted copies of the summary judgment papers, as well as redacted copies of those expert reports that were submitted in connection with the dispositive motions and/or the class certification motion, will then be available for inspection in the Clerk's Office.<sup>1</sup>

The Home Depot and Kohl's shall have until November 27, 2002, to opt out of the class.
