JOHN GLEESON, United States District Judge:

In light of Lead Counsel's letter of July 17, 2008, my order of that date adopting Special Master Robin Wilcox's report and recommendation of June 20, 2008 is vacated.

Having read the report and recommendation, and having noted that no party has objected to it, I adopt the report and recommendation in its entirety, understanding that the amount to be awarded to Cannonade Capital ("Cannonade") is as set forth in the analysis on page 18 of the report and recommendation, not in the summary sections on pages 2 and 20.

I therefore award Lead Counsel \$65,367.00 in legal fees and authorize an additional payment of \$134,179.09, consisting of payment for (1) \$31.50 for the fees and expenses of Brown Rudnick; (2) \$31,797.75 for the fees and expenses of CRA; (3) \$24,565.31 for the fees and expenses of Noblett; (4) \$76,150.00 for the fees of Cannonade; (5) \$1,028.42 for the fees and expenses of Apco; and (6) \$606.11 for Lead Counsel's miscellaneous costs and expenses (FedEx, photocopies, messenger service, offsite storage, online database research, postage, and telephone).
